Made in the Shade is a free shade tree program offered to both Burbank residents and businesses. BWP is offering this program to help our customers save electricity in the summertime. Studies show that properly sited shade trees can reduce air conditioning use by 10% to 50%.

How?

If you are a BWP customer interested in reducing your air conditioning use, simply call BWP's program arborist at 818.957.8196 to schedule an appointment. The arborist will come to your home or organization and help you select sites on your private property that can benefit from shade as well as appropriate trees for those sites. There are over two dozen trees to select from so you're sure to find a tree you'll love. Burbank residents can receive up to three free trees from BWP. Burbank businesses can receive up to 20 free trees. The trees we are offering are fairly mature. They come in 15-gallon

containers and weigh about 60 pounds. Within three weeks of your appointment your trees will be delivered to you. In addition to free trees, BWP is also providing stakes, ties, arbor guards and a video showing how to properly plant your trees. Again, all for free!

Call Dig Alert

Call Dig Alert prior to planting your trees. Dig Alert is a free service that contacts underground utilities on your behalf. This insures that your planting sites will not interfere with any underground utilities.



Plant Your Trees

Plant your trees as soon as possible and only in the locations you agreed to with the arborist. BWP conducts inspections to verify that the Made in the Shade trees have been planted in the correct sites. Residents and businesses that break this promise will be charged \$90 for every tree planted in the wrong location. Please remember that **Made in the Shade** is an energy-saving program, not a landscape program!



Take Care of Your Trees

Care for your trees! It doesn't take much effort to allow your shade trees to thrive. Properly plant them (watch the free video!) and give them enough water so that their roots can successfully establish. Do this and you should have many, many years of shade and beauty from your trees!
