



HIGH EFFICIENCY TOILET



HOW IT WORKS

Toilets are by far the main source of water use in the home, accounting for nearly 30 percent of an average home's indoor water consumption.

Toilets with a gallons per flush (gpf) rate higher than 1.6 are eligible to be replaced with a 1.1 or 0.8 gpf toilet. Replacing your high-water use toilet with a high efficient WaterSense labeled model can reduce the water used for toilets by 30 to 50 percent. That's nearly 13,000 gallons of water savings for your home every year.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- The specialist will determine if you have a high water use toilet eligible for replacement.
- Two appointments may be needed in order to complete this measure.
